1. CALL TO ORDER Julie Ann Woods 4:05 PM
2. ROLLCALL: Oscar Carlson, Jim Anathan, Jim Kehoe, Genoa Faber (Katherine Bell proxy given to Genoa)
3. Welcome New Members Joanne Houck and Joyce Shenk (not present)
4. Selection of 2016 Chairman and Vice Chairman
  - Motion to Appoint Genoa Faber as Chair- Jim Anathan made the motion seconded by Oscar Carlson Vote 4 in favor 0 opposed.
  - Motion to Appoint Agustin Goba as Vice Chair - Jim Anathan made the motion, seconded by Oscar Carlson Vote 4 in favor 0 opposed
5. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES FROM December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Motion to approve minutes Genoa Faber, Seconded by Jim Anathan. Vote 4-0
6. Review of RFQ:
  - Members that had change requests have notified Chase directly, so those changes have been made already.
  - Members would like to change the budget amount to the Base Plan budget so there leaves room for more money if needed. Julie Ann explained that Town preference is to leave amount as noted but change wording to "Base Budget". This will imply that budget could be modified, depending on qualifications.
  - RFQ is ready to be wrapped up and sent out as soon as possible.
7. Discussion on:
  - Guest Speaker- Ted O'Brien, Parks and Trails Manager  
Ted provided a map and informed the Board of 4 potential areas on the Town's trail system where art placement would be enjoyed by trail users.
    1. Nature Trail by the Picnic Tables
    2. North Rim in the Aspen Grove near the top by picnic tables (future intersection with the 7 Star trail)
    3. Town Park- popular starting point for bikers could incorporated Kiosk with bike trail information
    4. Up on the Ski Slopes- top of Village Bound and Government Trail. Future Node for several trail intersections.

In the packet it shows the trail locations on a map and Ted also included other bike art examples found on the Web.

Board liked the idea of developing ideas for potential art in these locations. The first priority is for Town Park; would like to see that installed this summer to help bikers know where go to find information. More discussion on this topic will be at the next

- Trash Can Art program-  
Board agreed to call the pilot program “Trash Art”  
Need to begin by finishing the 3 additional trash cans at the Mall Transit Depot.  
The board agreed to use the wording from the initial contract with Chris Erickson to set the parameters for the work to be completed and then just by word of mouth and email contacts send out requests to finish the additional 3 cans, which Chris could also propose to do. From the drawings that are received the Board will decide which three to go with. If all goes well the program will continue with trash cans throughout the village. Jim Kehoe agreed to help develop the “Call for Artists” solicitation for this project with assistance from Chase Anderson.

#### Town Council Presentation

A meeting with Town Council is scheduled (and confirmed by Chase Anderson) for Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 4 PM. Julie Ann Woods thought it was regarding the trash art; Jim Anathan inquired if it was the annual meeting of SAAB with Council. Julie Ann indicated she would have Chase clarify in an e-mail to the SAAB members. Genoa would coordinate with Chase, and all members would be encouraged to attend.

**Arts programming will:**




