a. Summer Meeting Recap:

Bob felt it was a really good meeting with lots of good information put forth by the invited speakers. The rest of the board agreed. Nancy & Greer kept everyone on schedule. Nancy felt the Snowmass Sun should be possibly covering our two public meetings. All in all it was fairly well attended and informative.

b. Update from Town Council Meetings

Nancy watched on line . Council could not comment on the lawsuit between Sunrise and Related. Richard Goodwin's lawsuit was ruled on. The September Town Council meeting on September 6th will be about status of the 10 amendments . Lawsuit definitely complicates things. Lis Pendance talked about. This is a legal issue. Going to talk about Building 6 that was promised to the Town Snowmass. The town needs a guarantee through either money or a grant.

Travis has added more part time resident e-mails to our list which is great. He said Sept 12, the mini roundabout construction will start. Greer talked about her concerns on some of the trails that intersect the roundabout area and will talk to Ann head person at Public Works with Travis soon. There is a concern on crosswalks, flashing lights at major intersections. We need to keep our residents safe. Travis also talked about Skittles being very successful. A woman at the town council mtg, Tony Kronenberg, talked about an aerial connecting Snowmass Center to Base Village. There was an audit report by Greg Smith -6 Mil. \$480 per 1 million accessed value. Also Wildcat, school district, Water, and Pitkin County Open Spaces also covered in the mil levy. Travis has a worksheet on assessments so we can figure out what it will cost each of us if interested. The Connectivity Plan has been postponed and a consultant will be hired by the Town. The Comprehensive Plan needs to be decided on first. Design elements planned in keeping with what the town has already planned. Surveys will be up on Website . Bob asked if part timers will have a chance to vet? He feels we need a sit down with planners before it is presented to The Town Council. The P.O.S.T.E.R. Was a long topic discussion at last Council meeting. The Pitkin Open Space wants an extension of mil levy to 2040. Travis also informed us that a new Verizon tower will be erected at Town Park shortly.
