




This bike rack depicts a more traditional "wave" like pattern for a multiple amount of bikes. On the ends are two decorative scenes: these are relatively thick (3/8") thick steel of "laminations" depicting the mountain scenes. Each side has 'hand forged' mountain wild flowers: wild sun flowers, geraniums, and columbines..... these flowers are ADHERED to the laminations so there is NO CHANCE of them being pulled off or detached in any way shape form or fashion from the project. The artist has already proven this possible by doing a similar project with hand forged wild flowers on a bridge in Salida, CO for another AIPP, so it is well understood that not only is this possibly but possible WITHIN the parameters of the committees suggestions/regulations regarding safety. The wild flowers represent the stunning beauty of the surrounding area and upon close inspection, one will find a butterfly or dragonfly or two attached to the scene! Each petal of each flower is done BY HAND.... again, a tribute the heritage of the local blacksmithing lore (see: story...)
