


**Snowmass Village Bike Rack Proposal
Heavy Scroll (Cinnamon Roll)**

All Work performed at the Roaring Forge LLC in Carbondale Colorado by the Artist.

Scrolls are formed hot from 1" solid round steel bar on jigs which I make. A hand forged 2" round finial is attached to the end of the scroll. It is then welded to a heavy base plate with 4 bolt holes. Another mounting option would be to weld extensions to the bottom of the scroll which could be inserted into holes drilled into concrete and grouted.

A natural rust finish would not only look great but would require no maintenance unless one wanted to apply a wax topcoat for additional sheen. The heavy material will only form a thin surface layer of oxide. I would however seal the bottom of the base with a cold galvanizing compound.

The price for one unit delivered is 975.00 with the natural brown patina. Powder-coat or galvanizing is also available for an additional 300.00 per unit
